### **Lisa Boylan**

Ms. **Boylan** graduated as a Special Agent from the Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) Academy and worked with the Los Angeles Field Division to disrupt and dismantle drug trafficking organizations. Boylan later graduated as a Special Agent with the FBI. She currently works on a Violent Crimes Investigation Squad in Los Angeles. Boylan's investigations include: fugitive apprehension, bank robberies, extortion, child exploitation, kidnapping, and gang activity.

### **Adam Foss**

Adam J. Foss is a former Assistant District Attorney for the Suffolk County District Attorney's Office in Boston, MA. Adam is a fierce advocate for criminal justice reform and the importance of the role of the prosecutor in ending mass incarceration. Mr Foss believes that the profession of prosecution is ripe for reinvention, requiring better incentives and more measurable metrics for success beyond simply, "cases won."

### **General Stephen Townsend**

General Townsend currently commands the U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC). TRADOC oversees 32 Army schools organized under eight Centers of Excellence, each focused on a separate area of expertise within the Army. These centers train over 500,000 Soldiers and service members each year. Townsend has commanded troops at every echelon from platoon to corps and combined joint task force. He has soldiered with four regiments (the 505th Parachute Infantry, 21st Infantry, 31st Infantry, and the 75th Ranger Regiment) and five divisions (the 82nd Airborne, 7th Infantry Division, the 10th Mountain Division, 2nd Infantry Division, and the 101st Airborne Division).
